Basic Survival Courses

mistakes which could be critical to our very survival.

What we aim to achieve at Prep to Survive is to provide quality Wilderness Safety and Skills training that is delivered by trained, skilled, and experienced individuals who look forward to helping you out on your first steps into this emergency preparedness realm. Or to help hone those already attained skills to bring you up to speed with

Basic Survival Course Overview



In order to complete the Prep to Survive Level 1 Wilderness Skills and Safety Training course certification. There are a number of mandatory core courses which will need to be achieved by the participants before level certification is presented. The core Courses are Basic Survival Course (2 days), Basic Bushcraft Course (1 day), Basic Wilderness Navigation (1 day), 3 Elective training courses (Numerous days). Some examples of these elective courses are Care and Use of Camp

tools, Canadian Non-Restricted Firearms Safety Course for Hunting, Introduction to Hiking and Trekking, Introduction to Orienteering, etc. Then the participants would have to book a weekend day with evaluating staff to be tested on what they have learned within Level 1. There would be practical and written tests plus an interview board. This is required to gauge where you are at with your knowledge and skills. Upon completion of these requirements Participants will be awarded a patch for the level and a certificate. They then would be eligible to sign up for Level 2 courses at the Intermediate Level.

Advanced Training Levels

Once a participant is certified in the Basic Level, they then are able to take more advanced training which is more physically and mentally demanding for the trainees. After the Basic level is completed there are Intermediate and Advanced training Levels.

Company Instructor Certification

When a Trainee becomes certified in the Advanced training Level. They will have the opportunity to apply to be enrolled in the Prep to Survive Instructor training level. Upon completion of the Wilderness Survival Instructor Training Level. The prospective instructor would be required to complete a practicum where they would have the opportunity to practice those attained Instruction / presentation skills. Then they would be offered employment within the Company.
